

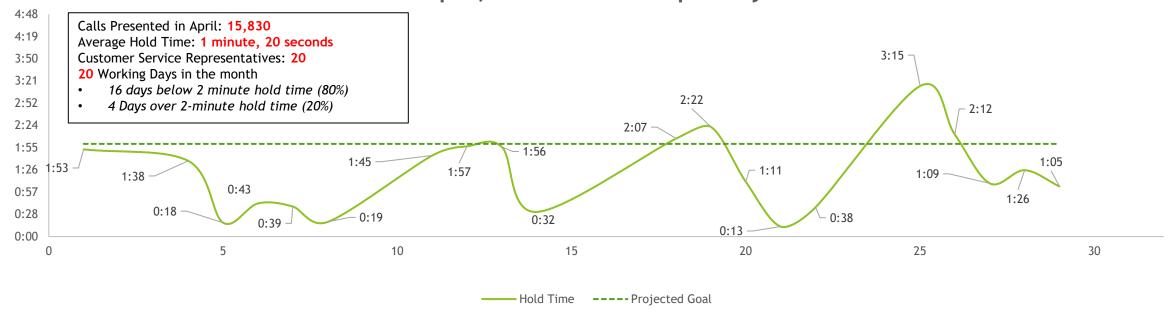

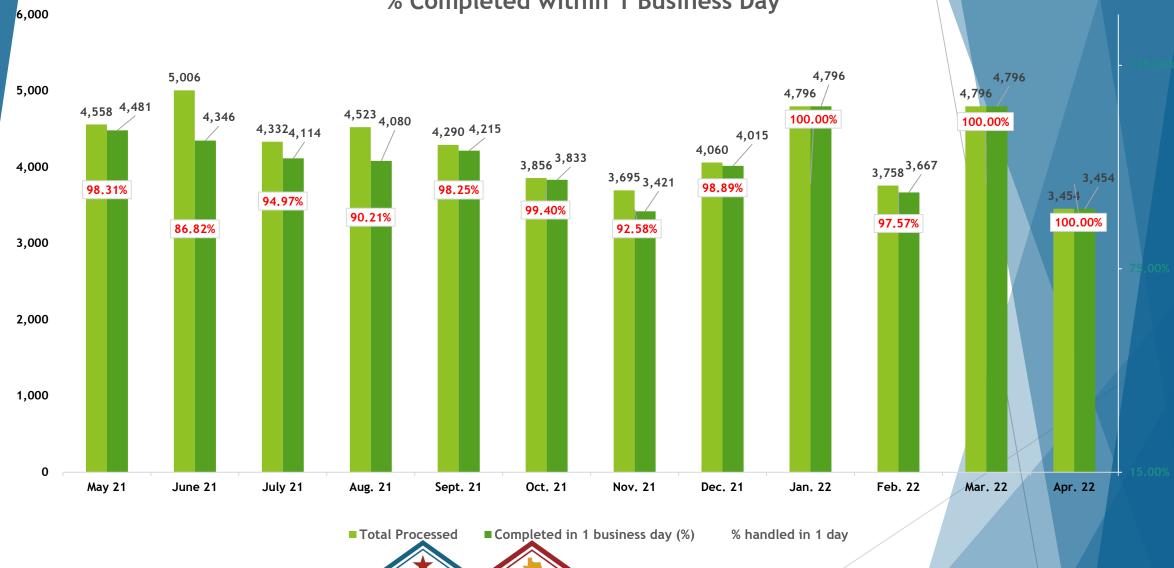


Last 12 Months Calls Presented vs. Hold Time

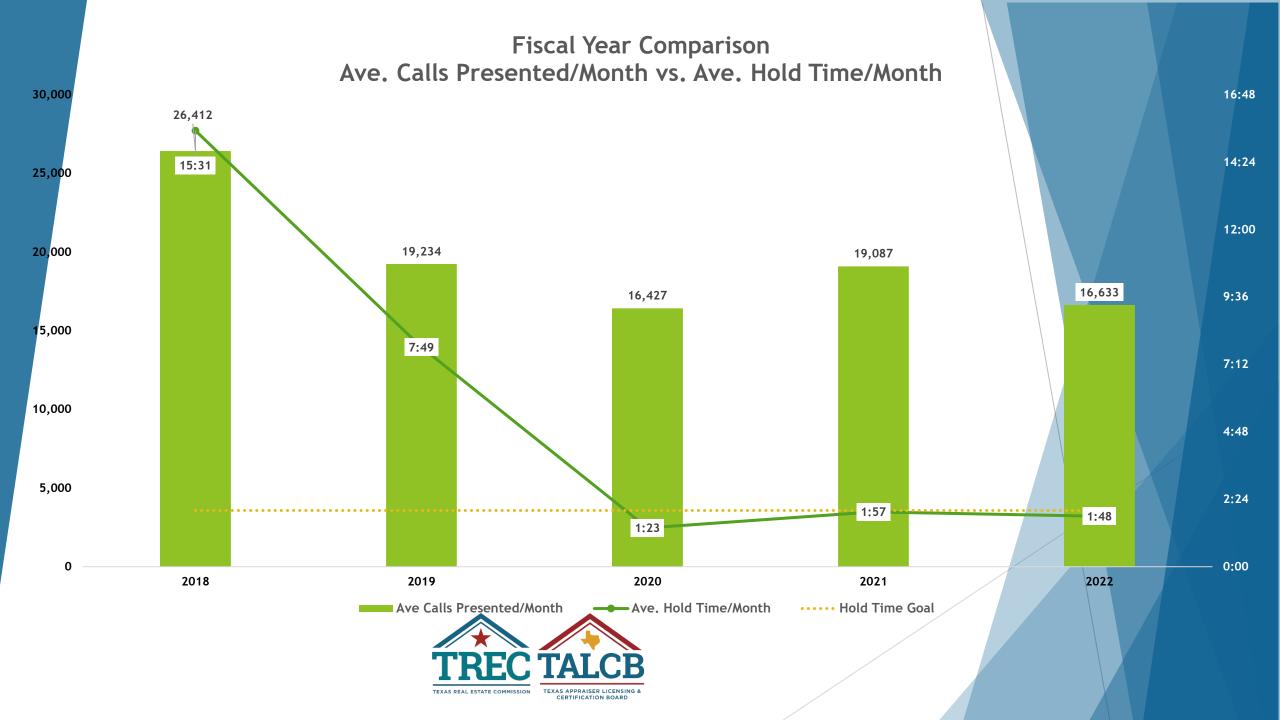




Last 12 Months Emails Processed and % Completed within 1 Business Day

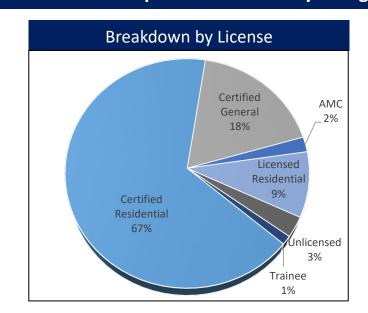


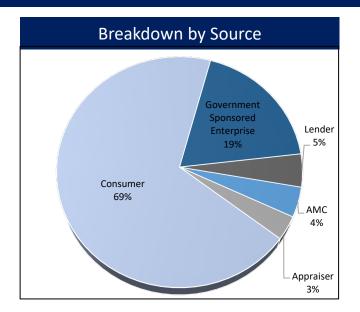




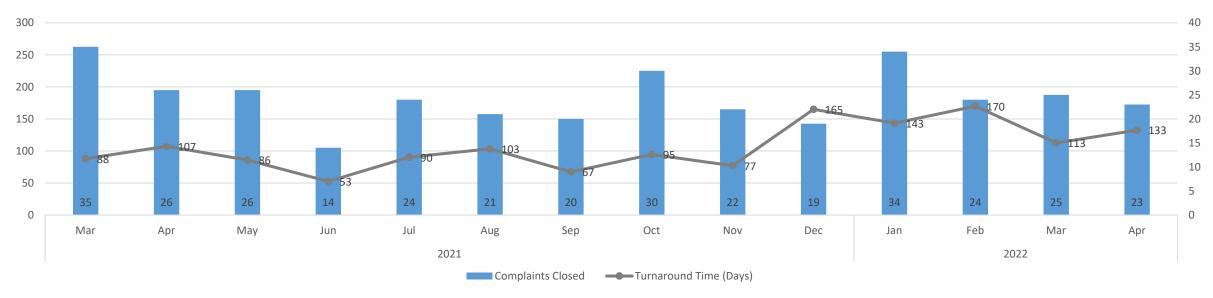
Fiscal Year 2022 Complaints Received by Category

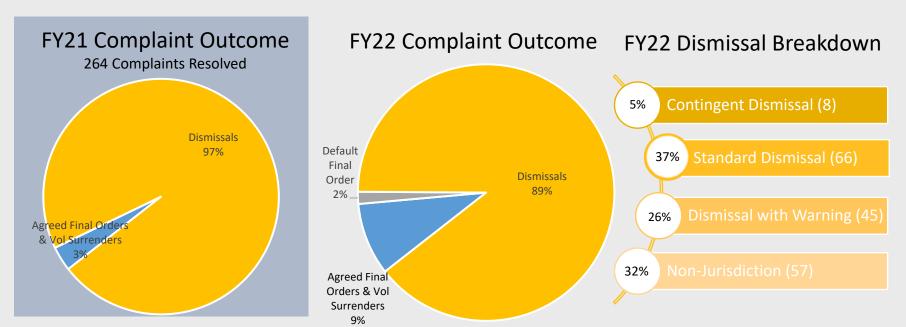
