

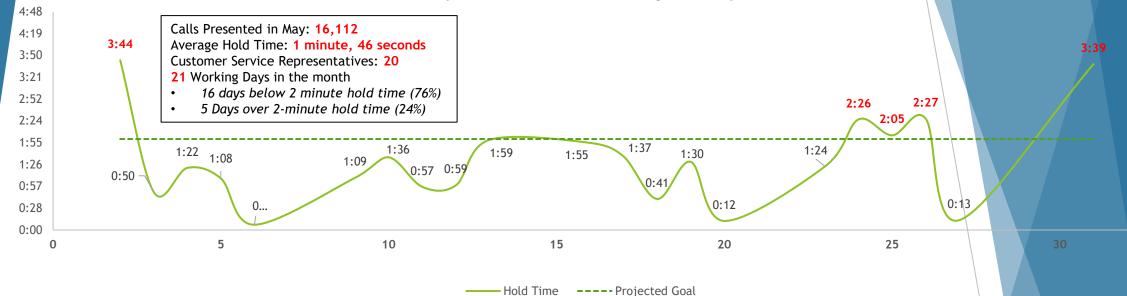

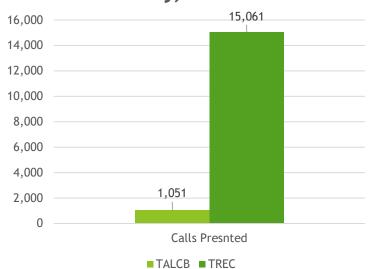

May, 2022 Hold Time per Day



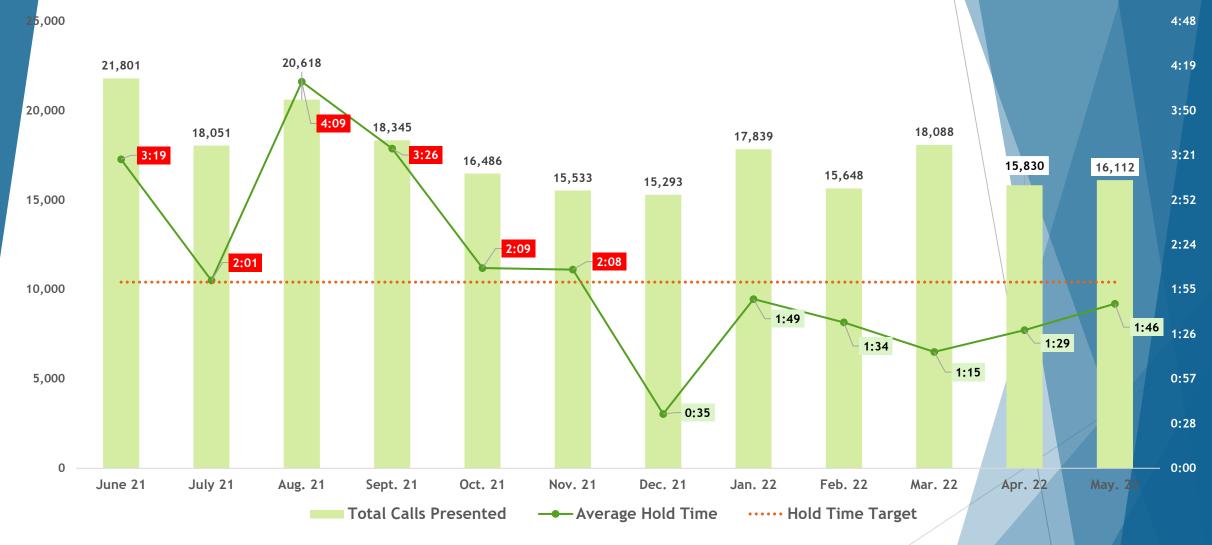

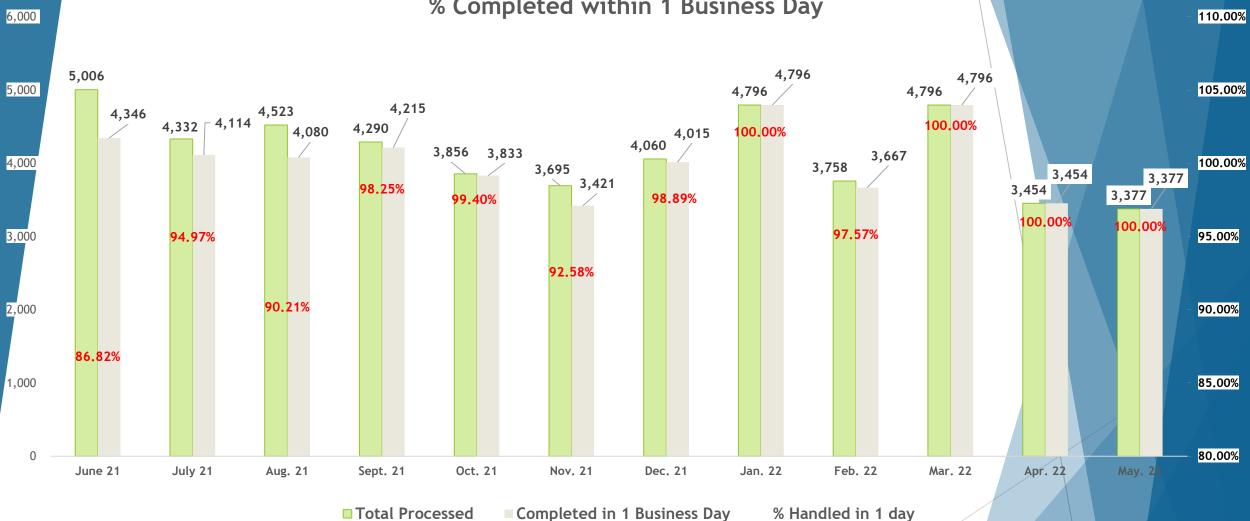


Last 12 Months Calls Presented vs. Hold Time









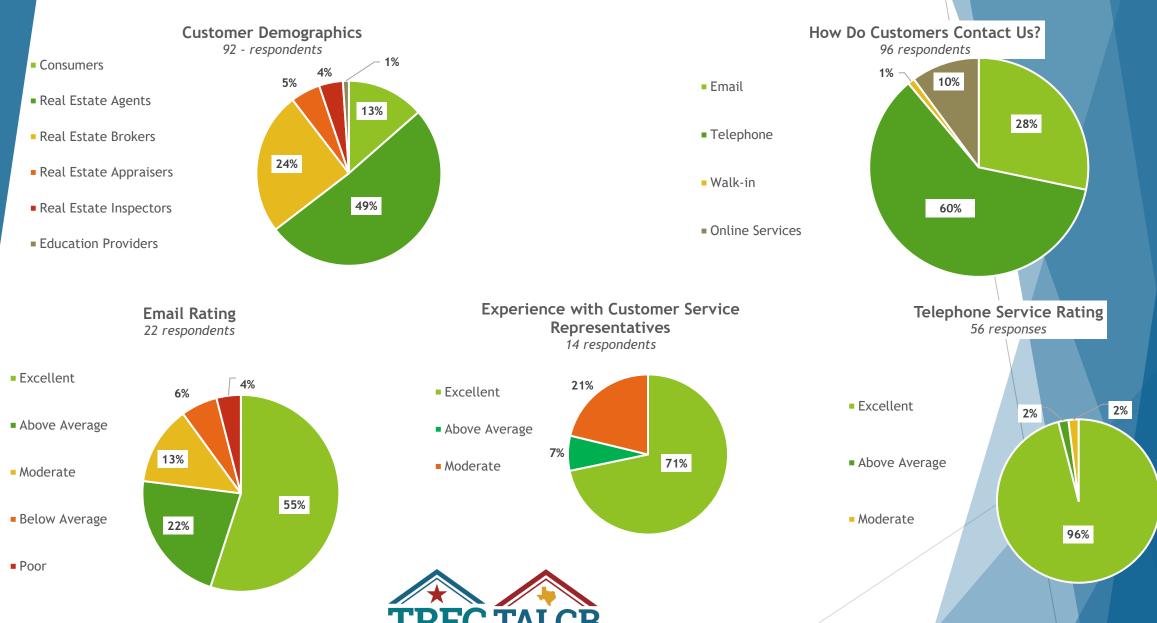


Fiscal Year Comparison Ave. Calls Presented/Month vs. Ave. Hold Time/Month

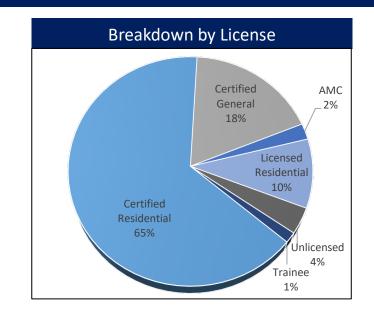


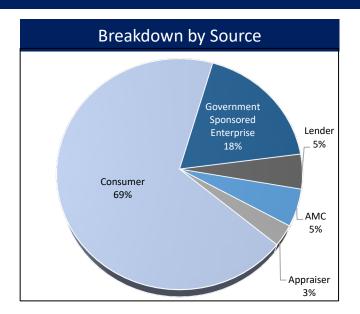




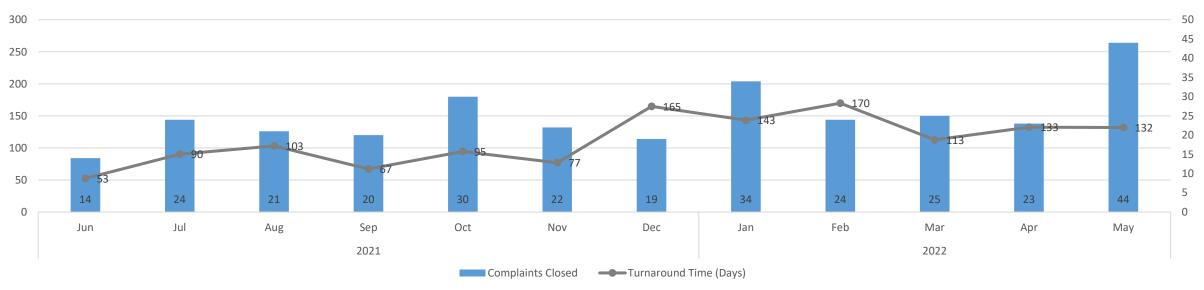
Fiscal Year 2022 Complaints Received by Category

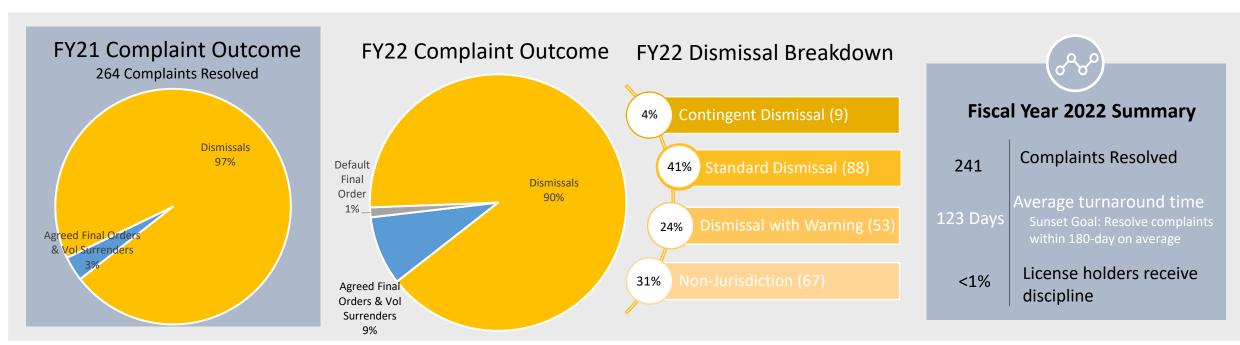
